4. Librarian Update:

- Chapters Adopt-a-School donation: \$5999.63, received on October 27, 2017
- 2-year plan: \$2037 spent to date; 1211 books added to Viscount collection since October 20, 2017, including Chapters purchases and outside donations
- \$3691.79 remaining
- \$1000 allocated to update non-fiction in English and French, and to meet curriculum needs.
